

## Mock-cable Ribbed Scarf

The idea for this pattern came from a stitch pattern in *Sensational Knitted Socks* by Charlene Schurch.

### Materials:

Patons Chunky Tweed (Acrylic/Wool Blend) – 3 skeins  
 U.S. Size 10 ½ (6.5 mm) Needles  
 Tapestry Needle

**Finished Dimensions:** 9 feet long by about 5 inches wide. I made this to wrap twice around the neck and drape nicely to the waist of someone six feet tall. Adjust the length to the wearer's tastes and height.

**Gauge:** Not important, but I was getting about 2.5 feet of scarf per skein of yarn.



### Abbreviations:

K: knit  
 K2tog: knit 2 stitches together  
 P: purl  
 MB: make border (garter stitch)

### Instructions:

This scarf has narrow garter stitch borders. 2 rows of garter on each end and a border of 2 garter stitches (knit every row) along the long sides.

Using long-tail cast on, cast on 26 stitches (counts as first row). Knit one more row (right side).

Begin Pattern Rows 1-4:

Row 1: MB, K2P2 to last 2 stitches, MB

Row 2, MB, P2K2 to last 2 stitches, MB

Row 3: MB, K2P2 to last 2 stitches, MB

Row 4 (mock cable): MB, \*P2, K2tog and leave both stitches on left needle, K first stitch and slip both stitches to right needle\* repeat to last 2 stitches, MB

**Note:** /k is the mock cable stitch (knit 2 together, leave on left needle; knit first stitch, slide both stitches to right needle).

Repeat Pattern Rows 1-4 until scarf is desired length (ending on Row 4). Knit two more rows (garter stitch). Cast off. Weave in ends. Add fringe if desired.
